The Southern California Safety Institute (SCSI) is Seeking an Instructor to Deliver a Flight Physiology/Aeromedical Course.

This is a contracted, part-time position. Airfare, per diem and lodging are provided by SCSI. The instructor will be paid an hourly rate for their time lecturing (approximately 24 hours). SCSI possesses some course material but selectee will be required to re-fine/develop in-class presentations.

The course is approximately 3 days in duration and will be held once a year in Redondo Beach, CA. It is delivered to air safety investigators and aviation safety professionals from government and civil aviation organizations from all over the world. Potential for European course delivery as well.

Candidates must show experience in teaching/public speaking and the ability to weave their experiences into the syllabus via case studies and personal experience.

PHYSICIANS TRAINING IN DIVING MEDICINE

THIS LONG-RUNNING COURSE trains physicians to recognize and treat diving medical emergencies. Course educational methodology includes lectures, case presentations, video clips, printed support materials, practical exercises, and Q&A sessions.

Applicants should possess an MD, DO, or equivalent degree. Preference will be given to those applicants who use the training in their geographic areas to enhance the safety of dive operations.
