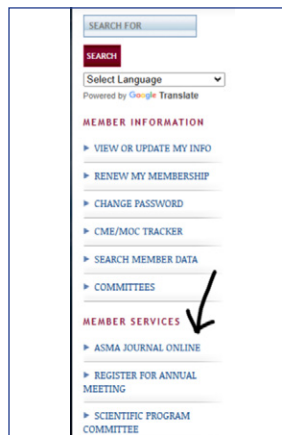


Recent Changes to AMHP Online

If you haven't visited the Blue Journal online recently, you'll note some changes when you do. The first is that we have changed hosting platforms. We announced this in September 2024 and made the changeover towards the end of that month. We continued to be hosted on Ingenta, our prior platform, until the end of December 2024. The new platform, PubFactory, now hosts both the current issues of the journal and all of the archives from 1929 to the present. All articles published in AsMA's journal can now be accessed in one place.

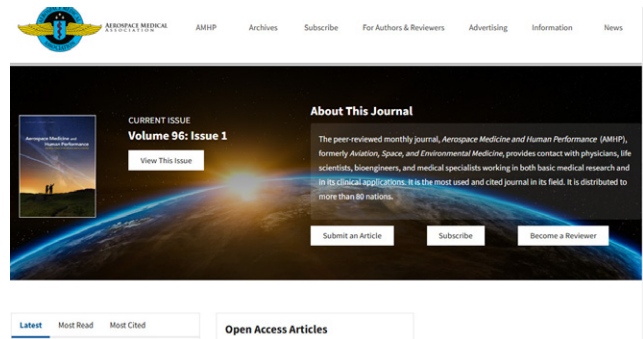

To access the new platform as a member, you will still log into the Members Only page using the boxes at the top right corner of the AsMA home page. Once on the Members Only page, in the left column, about a third of the way down, you will see a link labeled "AsMA Journal Online". Clicking that will take you to PubFactory logged in and you should be able to see all the content hosted there. You will be able to search keywords, authors, or titles as you did before.

For non-members and subscribers, you should still be able to log in as you did previously. For institutional subscribers, access is granted through IP address and PSI Org ID code. You can visit <https://app.theipregistry.org/> to look up your organization to see if they are registered.

Another change we made is to how long articles remain pay-per-view. After the platform change, we had past subscribers enquiring about permanent access to issues they had been subscribed to. A review of industry standards provided us important information and we decided to keep non-Open Access articles pay-per-view for only one year. After that, they become free to view and stay free to view. This will allow those whose subscriptions have lapsed to be able to view issues they were subscribed to. If a subscriber ends their subscription partway through the year, they will have to wait for the issues they were subscribed to during that year, but they will be able to view them once the pay-per-view period has ended. 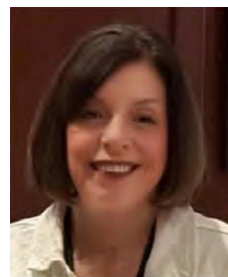
Front page of the PubFactory platform for AMHP.
